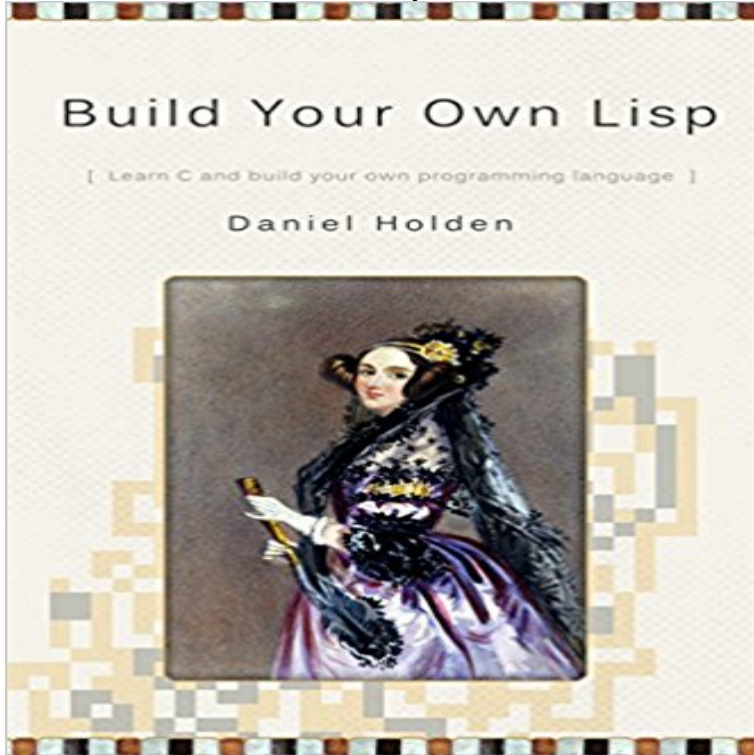


# Build Your Own Lisp
