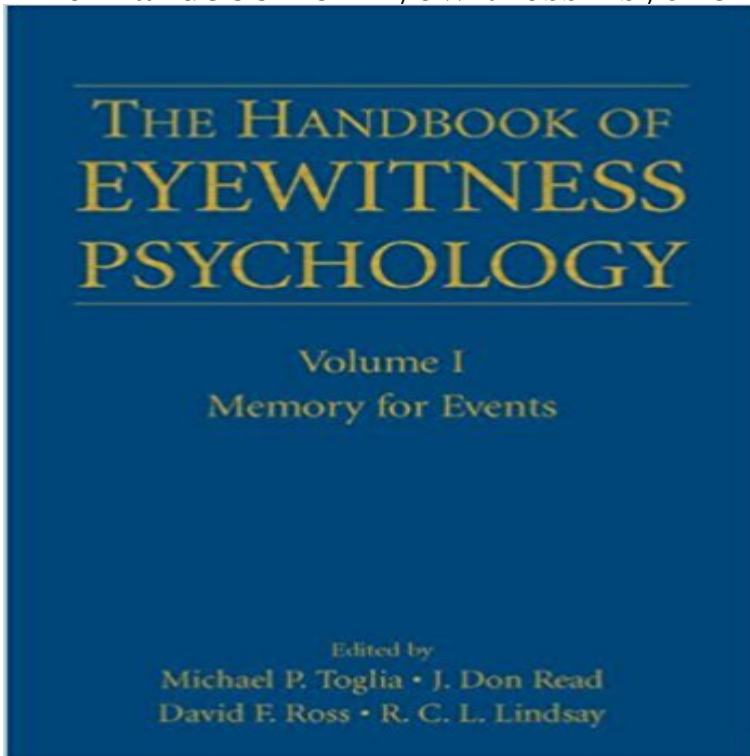


The Handbook of Eyewitness Psychology: Volume I: Memory for Events
