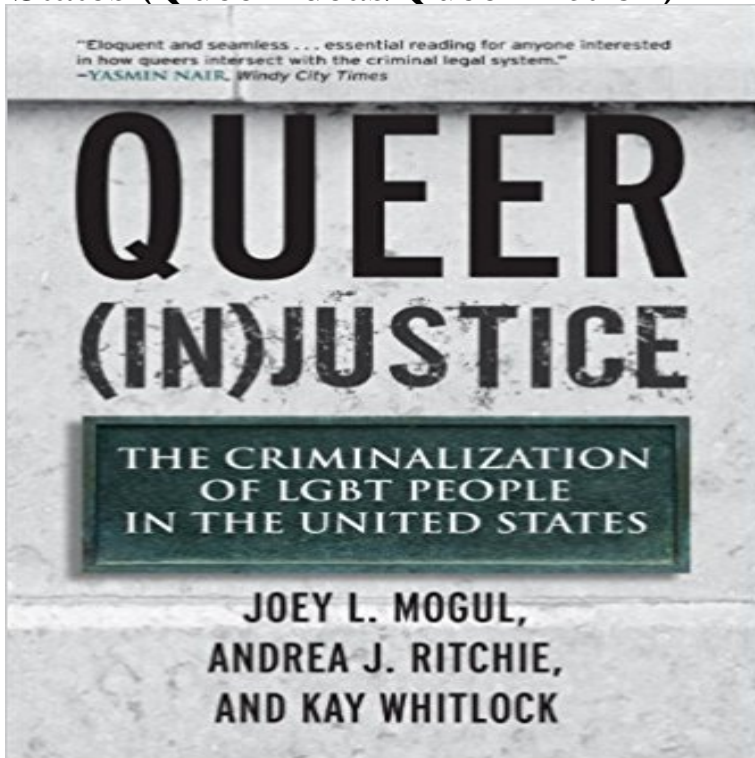


Queer (In)Justice: The Criminalization of LGBT People in the United States (Queer Ideas/Queer Action)
